The body of a white male was found along I-55 in Pemiscot County, MO on June 17, 1978. The male was wearing a red pullover short sleeve shirt with a circle on the chest. Inside the circle was a picture of a dark haired female with the words "Hot Sauce" underneath. The male was also wearing "Pentimento" brand blue jeans and brown or tan 9 inch lace up work boots, size 9 or 10. The subject had a tattoo of "J.H." on his outer right forearm. He also had a scar in the center of his forehead from between his eyebrows to his hairline. The subject was fair complected and had freckles. He was shot 3 times.

A young unidentified woman was also found 12 miles south along I-55 in Mississippi County, Arkansas on the same day. She also has a gunshot wound.
