CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTORS

This seminar is structured for the advanced homicide investigator and does not contain basic instruction. A great deal of effort has been expended to present some of the most renowned instructors in the world representing different fields of homicide investigation which include medical, forensic, scientific, and legal areas of expertise. Instructors scheduled to give presentations include:



DR. HENRY LEE

Dr. Henry C. Lee is one of the world's foremost forensic scientists. Dr. Lee's work has made him a landmark in modern-day forensic sciences. He has been a prominent player in many of the most challenging cases of the last 40 years. Dr. Lee has worked with law enforcement agencies in helping to solve more than 6000 cases. Dr. Lee is currently the Chief Emeritus for the Connecticut Department of Public Safety, Division of Scientific Services. He was the Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Public Safety for over two years and had served as that state's Chief Criminalist from 1979 to 2000. Dr. Lee was the driving force in establishing a modern State Police Forensic Science Laboratory in Connecticut.



DR. TRACEY COREY

"Dead Men Talking"

Dr. Corey is Chief Medical Examiner for the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Dr. Corey is a Consultant to the FBI National Center for the Analysis of Violent Crime in areas of Forensic Pathology and Pediatric Forensic Pathology since 1998. She has been an instructor throughout the United States and in Europe. Dr. Corey's presentation will include "Pattern Injuries" seen at the time of autopsy, causes of death and time of death determination, and will emphasize homicide investigations involving the death of children. A frequent speaker and contributor of her expertise to organizations throughout the country, she also teaches forensic pathology at the University of Louisville, and has been published in more than a dozen peer-reviewed journals and books.



LIEUTENANT ROBERT MERNER
SERGEANT DETECTIVE DANIEL DUFF

"Craigslit Killer"

Lieutenant Merner and Sergeant Detective Duff, of the Boston, Massachusetts Police Department were the lead investigators in the April, 2009, Craigslit Killer homicide investigation. They will provide insight and discuss the complicated aspects of this high profile investigation. Their presentation will include the crime scene investigation as well as the arrest and court proceedings of 22-year-old Boston University medical student, Phillip Markoff, who is accused of the crime.





MR. PHIL CHALMERS

"Inside the Mind of a Teen Killer"

Mr. Chalmers is America's leading authority on juvenile homicide and juvenile mass murder. He has interviewed over 200 teen killers and school shooters, and has been studying youth culture and teen murder for 25 years. Mr. Chalmers is the author of numerous books and documentaries including his two latest releases, "Inside the Mind of a Teen Killer" and "The Encyclopedia of Teen Killers." Instead of learning about these crimes from textbooks or libraries, Mr. Chalmers speaks to the killers themselves and has interacted with teen killers, serial killers, school shooters, and sexual predators; including Charles Manson, David Berkowitz, Pearl shooter Luke Woodham, and Paducah shooter Barry Loukaitis.



MR. LOU TESSMAN

"Crime Scene, Investigation, Conviction"

Mr. Tessman was a member of the Waukegan, Illinois Police Department. His 21 year career included patrol officer, homicide investigator, and ultimately Deputy Chief of Police. He recently retired as the Commander of the elite Lake County Major Crime Task Force. Mr. Tessmann is a motivational speaker and his presentation provides techniques to keep investigators focused throughout all stages of a homicide investigation. He has been a guest speaker on programs such as the Discovery Channel, Real Detective and America's Most Wanted.



MR. CHRIS HANSEN

Correspondent, "Dateline NBC"

Mr. Hansen will be the keynote speaker at our dinner banquet on Wednesday evening. Chris Hansen is a correspondent for NBC News' "Dateline NBC." Mr. Hansen is well-known for his many innovative breakthrough investigative news reports, specifically the series "To Catch a Predator". He is also well known for the reports on the identity theft epidemic, a year-long hidden camera investigation into the counterfeit prescription drug trade in China, and the War on Terror, to name a few. Hansen has received numerous awards including seven Emmys for investigative reporting.

LOCATION

This seminar will be held in Kansas City, Missouri, at the Westin Crown Center Hotel. The Crown Center Hotel is one of Kansas City's finest hotels, and has been given a Five Star rating. Seminar presentations will be given in the American Heartland Theater located in the hotel which features state of the art acoustical technology.
