**LOCATION:** Troop C - St. Louis Area; Manchester, Deer Creek, and South Kingshighway Driver Examination Stations

**DESCRIPTION:** These Driver Examiner positions are assigned to the Missouri State Highway Patrol's Troop C Headquarters. The official domicile for these positions includes the Manchester, Deer Creek, or South Kingshighway, Driver Examination Station. These positions are classified as non-exempt under the Fair Labor Standards Act.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** An employee in this position conducts a variety of driver license examinations to determine the eligibility of individual applicants for licensure. Employee interacts with the public on a daily basis in reference to all facets of the driver examination process. (For a more detailed job description go to:

**QUALIFICATIONS:** **Driver Examiner I:** Possess a high school diploma or GED. Be at least 21 years of age. Possess and maintain a valid Driver License. No convictions of a felony or any crime involving moral turpitude or have any indictment or information pending for any offense involving moral turpitude. Pursuant to General Order 26-04, employees who work in positions where interaction with the public or representatives of other agencies is likely, will conform to the same standards as uniformed civilians in regard to body piercing, brands, and tattoos. Applicants will not be hired for uniformed civilian positions if they have any tattoos or brands on the head, neck, hands, below the upper six-inch portion of the arms, or any other part of the body which would be visible while wearing any official uniform. **Driver Examiner II:** Meet all requirements for Driver Examiner I, plus possess one-year experience as a Driver Examiner I. **Driver Examiner III:** Possess at least 3 years experience as a Driver Examiner with the Missouri State Highway Patrol and have served at least two years as a Driver Examiner II.

**STARTING SALARY:** \$1,116.00; however salary will commiserate with applicable experience and education.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Individuals interested in any of these positions must submit the Patrol's Application for Employment prior to the application deadline of August 23, 2010. Resumes will not be accepted in lieu of the application. Applicants may obtain an application from the Patrol's website at [www.mshp.dps.missouri.gov](http://www.mshp.dps.missouri.gov), or by contacting the facilitator listed above.

Individuals who have completed an application for a position within the last twelve months may request their application be pulled for consideration by contacting the facilitator for the vacant position. If an application is older than twelve months, the applicant must submit a new application.

Current employees who meet the minimum qualifications set forth in the attached job description may apply through the Human Resources Division by submitting an intradepartmental letter of application and resume through channels prior to the application deadline.

Interview boards are tentatively scheduled for the week of September 6, 2010. The tentative start date for these positions is within 30 days of the interview.

Some Patrol duties relate to criminal activity. Therefore, employees may be exposed to written material, photographs, and/or verbal language of a sexual nature. The requirements of this position are not intended to create a hostile work environment; however, it is work of an extremely sensitive nature. A copy of the Missouri State Highway Patrol policy on sexual harassment is available upon request.

**NOTE:** Final selection may be based upon several factors, e.g., results of an oral interview, written examination or exercise, review of past work performance, performance evaluations and/or candidate's possession of the knowledge, skills and abilities deemed necessary for successful performance in the job.

Once a job offer has been made, employment with the Missouri State Highway Patrol is contingent upon the successful results of a Patrol administered drug test, favorable background investigation, and the results of a medical or psychological testing, when required.
