EMPHASIS: Missouri State Highway Patrol Schedules Buoy Hearing

Colonel J. Bret Johnson, superintendent of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, announces the following information pursuant to Section 306.124 RSMo.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is conducting a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, January 11, 2016, at Osage Beach City Hall, Highway 54, Osage Beach, Missouri, for the purpose of hearing testimony relating to uniform marking of water areas on Lake of the Ozarks in Benton, Camden, Miller and Morgan counties. All persons having submitted requests will be notified of time and place.
