DESCRIPTION: A position for Criminal Investigator/Polygraph Examiner now exists within the Troop H Unit of the Division of Drug and Crime Control. The official domicile for this position is St. Joseph, Missouri. This position is classified as non-exempt under the Fair Labor Standards Act. The member chosen for this position will be required to reside within the Troop H area.

POSITION SUMMARY: This is a specialized position in which an individual conducts criminal investigations normally within an assigned area. An employee in this position also assists Patrol and other law enforcement officers in crime scene processing, the collection and preservation of evidence, and conducting interviews of a variety of individuals. The employee also administers polygraph examinations to suspects, victims, witnesses, and informants involved in criminal and internal investigations. Work is performed under general supervision within established policies and procedures; however, independent judgment is required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Possess at least three consecutive years as a member of the Missouri State Highway Patrol.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Members must receive the proper Peace officer Standards and Training (POST) certification and maintain that certification while commissioned as a state trooper.

Must attend, graduate, and be certified by a polygraph school selected for attendance by the Director of the Division of Drug and Crime Control.

Must attend and graduate a basic Criminal Investigation School conducted by the Division of Drug and Crime Control.

Must attend and graduate a Crime Scene School conducted by the Division of Drug and Crime Control.

Must attend and graduate basic Narcotics Investigators School conducted by the Division of Drug and Crime Control.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Current MSHP members interested in this position must access the Patrol's [intranet site](#) to complete and submit an [application for employment](#) prior to the application deadline. Interview boards are tentatively scheduled for the week of March 21, 2016.
