POSITION AVAILABLE: Commercial Driver License (CDL) Examiner

SALARY RANGE (semi-monthly): The minimum starting salary for a Commercial Driver License (CDL) Examiner is \$1,986.00; however, salary may be commensurate with experience. Applicants who do not meet the required qualifications must first complete all Driver Examiner training before beginning CDL training and will start at the minimum starting salary of a Driver Examiner at \$1,786.00.

OFFICIAL DOMICILE: This position will be domiciled in Malden, MO or Sikeston, MO, and will be determined upon selection.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: This is a specialist position where the employee is accountable for administering the full range of Missouri driver license examinations, to include determining appropriate license categories and ensuring applicant qualifications, etc. At least 75% of this employee's time must be spent conducting more complex Commercial Driver License (CDL) examinations. CDL Examiners must be able to interact with the public during all weather conditions for extended periods of time. Work is performed independently under general supervision. This position is classified as non-exempt under the Fair Labor Standards Act.

*** If hired without required qualifications as a Commercial Driver License Examiner, successful completion of the Driver Examination Basic School is required- preferably within the first 12 months of employment and the Driver Examiner Field Training Program. Upon completion, the CDL minimum starting salary will take effect.**

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Current Patrol personnel interested in this position must access the Patrol's [intranet](#) to complete and submit an [application](#) prior to the application deadline. Positions requiring educational qualifications require all interested applicants, who have not already done so, to upload a copy of their college transcripts to the online application system. Resumes will not be accepted in lieu of the application. Individuals who have previously completed an application must access their profile in the system to re-apply.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Final selection may be based upon several factors, e.g., results of an oral interview, written examination or exercise, review of past work performance, performance evaluations, and/or candidate's possession of the knowledge, skills, and abilities deemed necessary for successful performance in the job.

Some Patrol duties relate to criminal activity. Therefore, employees may be exposed to written material, photographs, and/or verbal language of a sexual nature. The requirements of this position are not intended
