## TITLE: TEMPORARY CLERK

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**DESCRIPTION:** A Temporary Clerk position now exists within the Missouri State Highway Patrol's Gaming Division. The official domicile for this position is Jefferson City, Missouri. This position is classified as non-exempt under the Fair Labor Standards Act. *This position is approved for 1,000 hours of work during a 12-month period.* 

**POSITION SUMMARY:** This is an entry-level position where the employee is responsible for accurately encoding data into the computer database via the personal computer. An employee in this position is closely supervised.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from high school or possess a GED.

Possess the skill to type at a rate of 40 words per minute with ten (10) errors or less.

<u>APPLICATION PROCEDURE</u>: Individuals, including current Patrol employees, interested in this position must visit our website at <u>www.mshp.dps.mo.gov</u> to complete and submit an <u>application</u> and typing test (<u>http://mshp-hrd.AssessTyping.com</u>) prior to the application deadline. Resumes will not be accepted in lieu of the application. Individuals who have previously completed an application must access their profile in the system to re-apply.

The tentative start date for this position is within 30 days of the interview. Interviews will be scheduled as applications are received.

Some Patrol duties relate to criminal activity. Therefore, employees may be exposed to written material, photographs, and/or verbal language of a sexual nature. The requirements of this position are not intended to create a hostile work environment; however, it is work of an extremely sensitive nature. **<u>NOTE</u>**: Final selection may be based upon several factors, e.g., results of an oral interview, written examination or exercise, review of past work performance, performance evaluations, and/or candidate's possession of the knowledge, skills, and abilities deemed necessary for successful performance in the job.

Once a job offer has been made, employment with the Missouri State Highway Patrol is contingent upon the successful results of a Patrol administered drug test and favorable background investigation.
