


Missouri State Highway Patrol personnel from across the state performed school bus inspections between February 4 & April 30

MVI statistics are based upon the <u>initial</u> inspection of buses; approvals obtained after the repair of defective/out of service items are not reflected in official statistics.




2013 INSPECTION RESULTS


