Colonel J. Bret Johnson, superintendent of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, announces the following information pursuant to Section 306.124 RSMo.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is conducting a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 11, 2017, at Osage Beach City Hall, Highway 54, Osage Beach, Missouri, for the purpose of hearing testimony relating to uniform marking of water areas on Lake of the Ozarks in Camden and Morgan counties. All persons having submitted requests will be notified of time and place.

Applicants have made the following requests to be addressed at the January 11, 2017, hearing:

Bruce Thomason requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' at a 45 degree angle from the northeastern corner of the dock located at 3.2 MM, Gladstone Cove, Morgan County. This application was tabled at the November 2016 hearing and will be reviewed a second time.

Harold Collins requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 42.1 MM, Loveland Cove, Camden County. This application was tabled at the November 2016 hearing and will be reviewed a second time.

Jessie Logan requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 26.2 MM, Crabtree Cove, Camden County.

Joshua Myers requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the southeastern corner of the dock located at 21.1 MM, Salt Hollow Cove, Camden County.

Michael Dippel requests two (2) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed 100' at a 45 degree angle from the corners of the dock located at 3.9 MM, Mill Creek Cove, Morgan County.

Michael and Stephanie Dyer request one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the northeastern corner of the dock located at 4.3 MM, Gravois Main Channel, Morgan County.

Otto Tucker requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the northeastern corner of the dock located at 1.7 MM, Big Niangua Main Channel, Camden County.

The Palms Homeowners Association requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the northwestern corner of the dock located at 9.1 MM, Osage Main Channel, Camden County.

Pleasant Valley II Association requests three (3) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed evenly spaced across the cove to create a No Wake Cove at 43.8 MM, Bollinger Creek Cove, Camden County.
