EMPHASIS: Missouri State Highway Patrol Schedules Buoy Hearing

Lieutenant Colonel Eric T. Olson, acting superintendent of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, announces the following information pursuant to Section 306.124 RSMo.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is conducting a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, March 11, 2019, at Osage Beach City Hall, Highway 54, Osage Beach, Missouri, for the purpose of hearing testimony relating to uniform marking of water areas on Lake of the Ozarks in Camden, Miller, and Morgan counties. All persons having submitted requests will be notified of time and place.

David Gray requests to modify permit 11-22 by establishing the no wake cove as full-time, located at 6.0 MM Gravois, Dry Branch Cove, Morgan County.

David Mikesic requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 1.9 MM, Gravois Main Channel, Morgan County.

Dennis Zacheis requests three (3) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed evenly spaced across the cove to create a no wake cove located at 8.3 MM, Workman Hollow Cove, Camden County.

Jeff Dodge requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 5.2 MM, Lick Branch Cove, Morgan County.

Jim Werner requests three (3) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed evenly spaced across the cove to create a no wake cove located at 3.3 MM, Jackson Branch Cove, Miller County.

Stacy Smith requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 5.0 MM, Main Channel, Camden County.

Terry & Debi Willson request one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 29.4 MM, Buccaneer Cove, Camden County.

Thomas Bart requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 7.2 MM, Triangle Cove, Morgan County. This application was tabled at the January 2019 hearing.

Thomas Kutz requests one (1) No Wake-Idle Speed buoy placed 100' from the center of the dock located at 26.1 MM, Main Channel, Camden County.
