EMPHASIS: Missouri State Highway Patrol Schedules Buoy Hearing

Colonel Sandra K. Karsten, superintendent of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, announces the following information pursuant to Section 306.124 RSMo.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is conducting a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, November 13, 2017, at Osage Beach City Hall, Highway 54, Osage Beach, Missouri, for the purpose of hearing testimony relating to uniform marking of water areas on Mark Twain Lake in Monroe County. All persons having submitted requests will be notified of time and place.

Applicants have made the following requests to be addressed at the November 13, 2017, hearing:

Mark Twain State Park requests four (4) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed approximately 400' out from the Route U boat ramp, spaced 125' apart with the end buoys set 125' from each shoreline.

Mark Twain State Park requests four (4) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed across the entrance to the cove at the Highway 107 boat ramp, spaced approximately 75' apart with the end buoys set 75' from each shoreline.

Mark Twain State Park requests three (3) No Wake-Idle Speed buoys placed near the State Park Campground boat ramp with the middle buoy set approximately 150' out from the ramp and the remaining buoys placed out approximately 75' from the middle buoy.

Mark Twain State Park requests to modify buoy permit 89-04 at the State Park Swim Beach by adding two (2) Danger buoys set 25' from the shore near the southeastern-most buoy to mark a shallow area.
