The body of a Hispanic/Latino male was found in a dodge neon that was being transferred to the United States in a railway freight car. It is believed that the victim snuck into the car while it was being loaded onto the train in Toluca, Mexico. He was found during high environmental temperatures and it is believed that the cause of death was hyperthermia. The victim was wearing a black shirt that had "Dunk" written on it with a basketball player doing a slam dunk and gold stars around it, denim Surrez jeans, and a black belt that's buckles was made of black metal and "Kal" engraved in it. He had an extra tooth between his two front teeth, and Dental records are available. Also, upon request, a full body X-Ray can be obtained.
