On October 26, 2013, the skull of an 8-13 year old child was discovered on private property near the intersection of Hwy 28 & Hwy D in Pulaski County, MO. The skull is missing the lower jaw.

An Anthropological Report was unable to determine the gender of the remains or time of death, but it is estimated that the child had been deceased at least one year before being found. The anthropologist noted the child was likely of Mestizo ancestry, which is an admixture of Native American, Hispanic, Latino and Mexican. The below images are a facial reconstruction completed by a NCMEC Forensic Artist that depicts what the child may have looked like in life. The artist used the skull to create two images of the child. One that depicts the child as a female and the other as a male. Since the lower jaw was not recovered, the jaw is the artist's interpretation and only an approximation.

MtDNA profiles were developed and have been submitted to CODIS. Limited dental charting is also on file.
